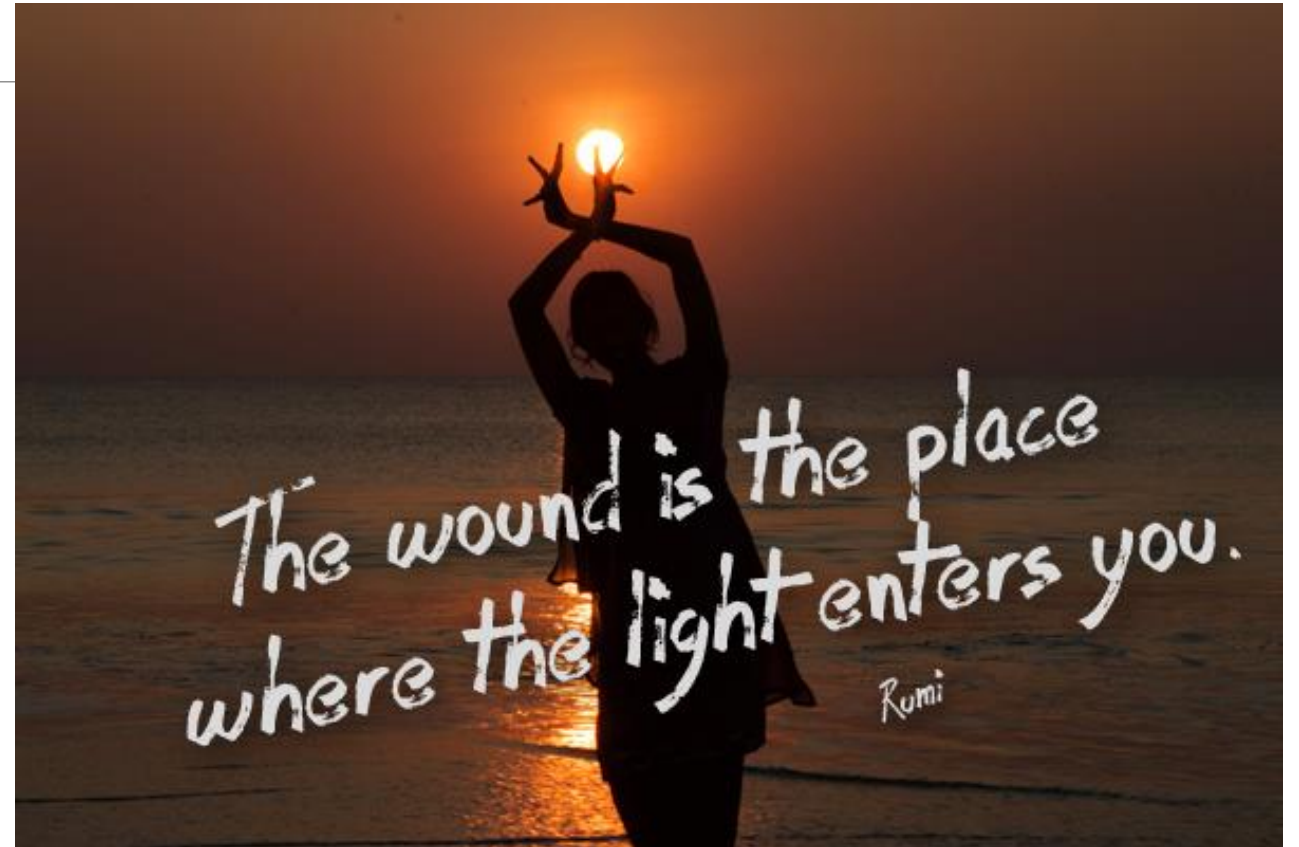
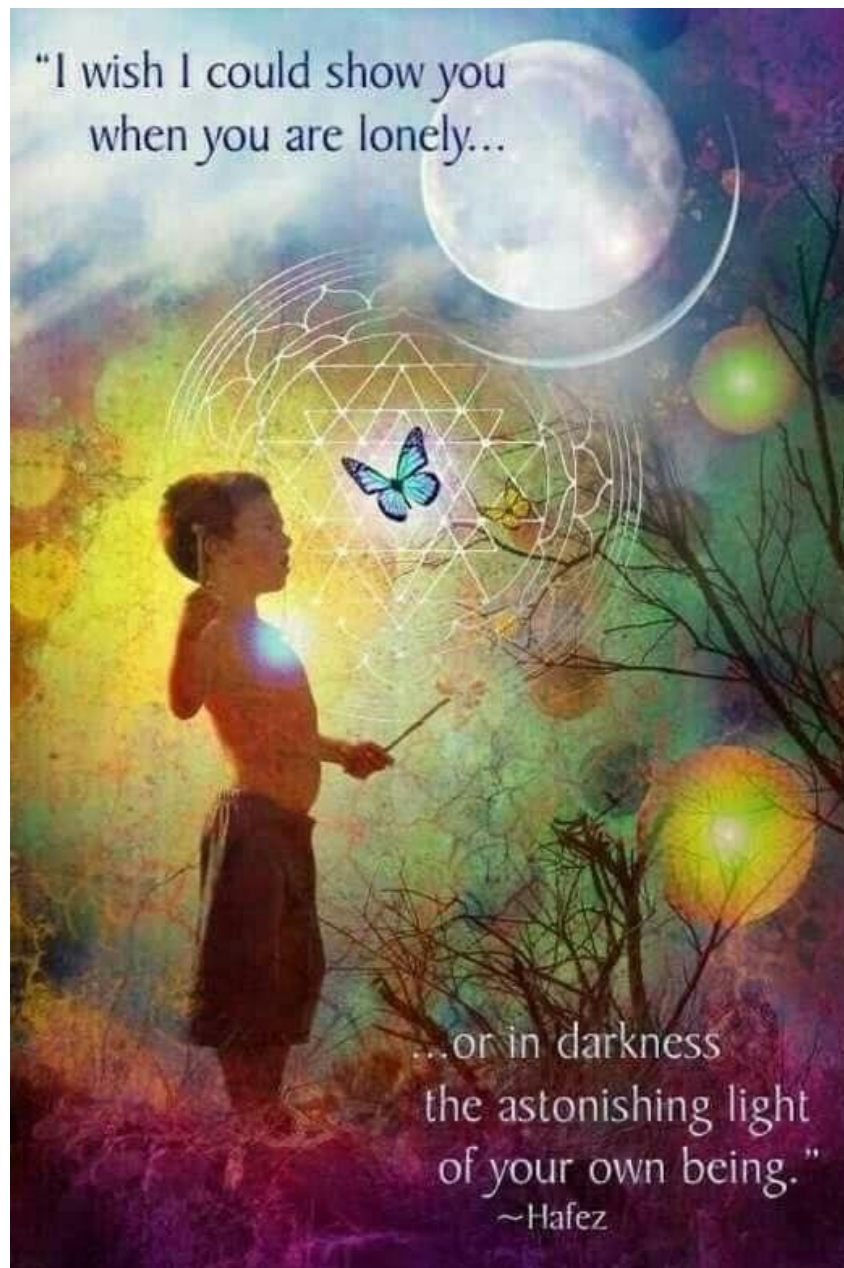

that what he does is done in God.'






# Guest
